1. SCHOLARSHIP

1.1 Application for Scholarship Guidelines

(a) The application for scholarship guidelines and the application form will be posted on the internet, at www.fgv.br/processoseletivo, menu 'Results', upon the announcement of the selection process outcome.

(b) In no event will untimely applications be accepted.

1.2 Business Administration Undergraduate Course

1.2.1 Merit Scholarship

Scholarship will be awarded to the four students ranking first in the Admission Exam, as follows:

UNIVERSITY ADMISSION EXAM
Ranking First - 100%
Ranking Second - 50%
Ranking Third - 30%
Ranking Fourth - 20%

- In the event that an applicant ranking first to fourth does not enter the university, the scholarships will be awarded based on score.

a. Maintenance conditions:

The conditions for maintaining this scholarship modality require the beneficiary to:

- obtain an accrued general average equal to or greater than 6 (six);
- behave in a manner compatible with academic standards;
- not to interrupt their studies in the course in which they excelled in the corresponding Admission Exam, except in the following events:
 - Interruption due to student exchange promoted by a program supported by FGV EAESP, lasting no more than one school year; and
 - Call to serve the Brazilian nation.

- b. Failing to meet the scholarship maintenance conditions leads to absolute extinguishment.

1.2.2 Non-refundable scholarship

- Scholarships for students in economic difficulties, applicable to students who pass the modalities: Admission Exam and ENEM.

In the aggregate, up to ten (10) full non-refundable scholarships (100%) will be awarded to students who passed the Admission Exam and ENEM modalities, considering, respectively, the applicant's socioeconomic status and ranking in our selection process.

- a. The scholarship will be awarded for the period necessary for fulfillment of the 240 credits that make up the syllabus: for 08 semesters, foreseen for the completion of the Undergraduate Course in Business Administration - Daytime; and for 10 semesters, foreseen for the completion of the Undergraduate Course in Business Administration - Night Time.
- b. Applicants for such scholarships will be selected based on the following criteria:
 - i. Properly proven economic and financial need;
 - ii. Performance in the selection process.
- c. Maintenance conditions: The conditions for maintaining this scholarship modality require the beneficiary to:
 - obtain an accrued general average equal to or greater than 6 (six);
 - behave in a manner compatible with academic standards;
 - not to interrupt their studies in the course in which they excelled in the corresponding Admission Exam, except in the following events:
 - Interruption due to student exchange promoted by a program supported by FGV EAESP, lasting no more than one school year; and
 - Call to serve the Brazilian nation;
 - Not showing a significant change in their economic and financial situation.
- d. Failing to meet the scholarship maintenance conditions leads to absolute extinguishment.
- e. Students who are attending the Undergraduate Course cannot apply for merit or economic need scholarships, in case of re-entry to the course through a new selection process.
- f. Scholarships for economic need include school fees (40% of the tuition fee) in case of student exchange for one semester.

1.2.3 Refundable Scholarships, applicable to students who passed both the modalities Admission Exam and ENEM.

- a. FGV EAESP grants, to Undergraduate students with proven need, financing of scholarships with mandatory reimbursement, without interest, updated by the IGP-M oscillation, in the following modalities:
 - Scholarship (from 20% to 100% of the tuition fee for the semester);
 - School Supplies Allowance (semester grant for books and school supplies);
 - Food Stamp (semester grant for food support);
 - Housing Allowance (semester grant to students in greater economic difficulties and living outside the city of São Paulo);
 - Transportation Allowance (semester grant to students in greater economic difficulties and living outside the city of São Paulo).
- b. The acceptance of the student's application for Refundable Scholarship Modality, granted by the FGV EAESP Scholarship Fund, will depend on the financial availability in each semester, as well as the number of applications and the percentages requested.
- c. Maintenance conditions: The conditions for maintaining this scholarship modality require the beneficiary to:
 - obtain an accrued general average equal to or greater than 6 (six);
 - behave in a manner compatible with academic standards;
- d. The Refundable Scholarship Modality does not include the financing of: enrollment cancellation.

1.3 Public Administration Undergraduate Course

The Public Administration Undergraduate Course in São Paulo FGV EAESP offers scholarships to students who pass the Selection Process in the following modalities:

1.3.1 Merit Scholarship

Scholarship will be awarded to the four students ranking first in the Admission Exam, as follows:

UNIVERSITY ADMISSION EXAM
Ranking First - 100%
Ranking Second - 50%
Ranking Third - 30%
Ranking Fourth - 20%

- In the event that an applicant ranking first to fourth does not enter the university, the scholarships will be awarded based on score.

1.3.2 Non-refundable scholarships

In the aggregate, up to ten (10) full non-refundable scholarships (100%) will be awarded to students who passed the Admission Exam and ENEM modalities, considering, respectively, the applicant's socioeconomic status and ranking in our selection process.

- a. Applicants for such scholarships will be selected based on the following criteria:
 - i. properly proven economic and financial need;
 - ii. performance in the selection process.
- b. Maintenance conditions: The conditions for maintaining this scholarship modality require the beneficiary to:
 - i. obtain an accrued general average equal to or greater than 7 (seven);
 - ii. behave in a manner compatible with academic standards;
 - iii. not to interrupt their studies in the course in which they excelled in the corresponding Admission Exam, except in the following events:
 - Interruption due to student exchange promoted by a program supported by FGV EAESP, lasting no more than one school year; and
 - Call to serve the Brazilian nation;
 - Not showing a significant change in their economic and financial situation.
- c. Failing to meet the scholarship maintenance conditions leads to absolute extinguishment.
- d. Students who are attending the Undergraduate Course cannot apply for merit or economic need scholarships, in case of re-entry to the course through a new selection process.
- e. Scholarships for economic need include school fees (40% of the tuition fee) in case of student exchange for one semester.

1.3.3 Refundable scholarship, applicable to students who passed the modalities: Admission Exam, ENEM, and International Exam IB, IBTUR, BAC and SAT.

- a. FGV EAESP grants, to Undergraduate students with proven need, financing of scholarships with mandatory reimbursement, in the following modalities:
 - i. Scholarship (from 20% to 100% of the tuition fee for the semester);
 - ii. School Supplies Allowance (semester grant for books and school supplies);
 - iii. Food Stamp (semester grant for food support);
 - iv. Housing Allowance (semester grant to students in greater economic difficulties and living outside the city of São Paulo);
 - v. Transportation Allowance (semester grant to students in greater economic difficulties and living outside the city of São Paulo). The acceptance of the student's application for Refundable Scholarship Modality, granted by the FGV EAESP Scholarship Fund, will depend on the financial availability in each semester, as well as the number of applications and the percentages requested.

- b. Maintenance conditions: The conditions for maintaining this scholarship modality require the beneficiary to:
 - i. obtain an accrued general average equal to or greater than 6 (six);
 - ii. behave in a manner compatible with academic standards;
- c. The Refundable Scholarship Modality does not include the financing of: enrollment cancellation.
- d. FGV EAESP has a Scholarship Fund that offers students the possibility of requesting reimbursable financing for tuition fees.
